Job Description

Assists the Test Officer with test preparation, set-up, execution, logistics, and reporting. Performs a variety of duties, including the following: writes or contributes to test plans, summer range scheduling and coordination with the Range Planning Division. Prepares and staffs Private Industry Contracts. Prepares and staffs cost estimates. Monitors test funds, expenditure organizations. Monitors and prepares documentation to clear cost overruns. Manages test scheduling and resourcing in Project Management Module (PMM). Assists with test coordination the YPG ranges. Selects, sets-up, and operates standard test equipment and record test data. Provides technical representation at meetings and working groups. Provides on-site support team environment. Demonstrates exceptional customer service skills both in person, on the telephone, and in written correspondence (such as e-mail). Performs highly difficult tasks the Sensors Branch, Aviation Systems & Electronic Test (ASET) Division, Air Combat Directorate, Yuma Test Center. Primary mission area is research and development testing of a programs approximately 50% of the time. Requires advanced knowledge gained from training and experience as a Special Forces Weapons Specialist or equivalent. Border Security per quarter for periods of 1-3 weeks per trip. Exercises discretion and applies judgement when applying advanced knowledge to international situations. Must work toward achieving full as assigned to complete the assigned mission.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Must be a U.S. Citizen and not hold multiple citizenships.
- Must have successfully served in the U.S. Army as a Special Forces Weapons Sergeant (18B) or other U.S. military service equivalent.
- Must have experience traveling and working in overseas areas.
- Must possess a valid driver's license, without special restrictions.
- Must possess a secret security clearance and maintain clearance for duration of employment.
- Must be able to work all shifts, weekends, holidays, and overtime as needed – sometimes on short notice – to support test missions.
- Must be able to travel for off-site duties up to 20% of time.
- Must have dependable transportation and a dependable means of communication.
- Must be punctual, responsible, reliable, trustworthy, and dependable.
- Must be able to use two-way radios, email, and cellular phones for communications.
- Must have excellent skills with Microsoft Office - including Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and Outlook.
- Must have excellent oral and written communication skills in English and be able to convey information clearly to management, customers, coworkers, employees, and government in a professional manner.
- Must have a positive, well-mannered customer service attitude and the ability to maintain a strong customer service attitude at all times.
- Must have demonstrated experience as highly motivated; self-directed; able to set priorities and meet deadlines; able to follow through on complex projects; and strong analytical, critical thinking, and problem-solving skills.
- Must have a demonstrated ability to understand, follow, and enforce policies, instructions, regulations, etc.
- Must have the ability to multi-task in a stressful, fast-paced work environment, be highly organized, and possess the willingness to adapt to any situation.
- Must have demonstrated ability to identify existing and predictable hazards in field operations, and take prompt corrective measures to eliminate them.
- Must have held positions of progressive leadership and be able to provide leadership and motivation to subordinate employees.
- Must be able to work in a team setting, fostering teamwork, and maintaining a professional relationship with all team members and coworkers, in and outside of your immediate work environment.

Physical Requirements:

- Must pass a pre-employment drug screening and physical.
- Must be able to work long and varied hours.
- Must be able to wear appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for work tasks assigned.
- Must be capable of frequent bending, squatting, crouching, kneeling, standing, climbing, and stooping, sometimes for long periods.
- Must be able to ascend and descend equipment.
- Must be able to visually distinguish colors.
- Must be capable of lifting and transporting 75 lbs. unassisted over uneven ground for 50 feet.
- Must be capable of working in extreme weather conditions including summer temperatures peaking around 120 degrees Fahrenheit.
- Must meet the physical requirements necessary to perform operations outlined, performed, and stated in the SOPs for TRAX and ASET.

Desired Qualifications:

- Bachelor of Science degree in a related field, such as engineering, technology, physics, etc.
- Knowledge of government office procedures and prior work experience in government office environment.
- A working knowledge of YTC Range procedures, and ASET SOPs and procedures.
- Ability to train subordinate personnel in their duties and responsibilities.
- Ability to interpret scheduling requirements from multiple sources and efficiently schedule personnel and equipment.
